Preparing for Your SUD Assessment

Required for All Appointments:

Valid photo ID and appropriate payment are required. If you have any documentation related to the reason for your referral or appointment, please bring it with you. Your clinician may request additional information during the session.

Urinalysis Requirement:

A urinalysis is required on the same calendar date as your assessment. Testing must be observed and must screen for the following substances: Alcohol, Benzodiazepines, Cannabis, Cocaine, Methamphetamine/Amphetamine, and Opioids. Confirmation testing may be required. See the attached lab information sheets for recommended providers near our Spokane office. Availia can assist by sending provider orders to a lab or clinic of your choosing. Many labs accept walk-ins without orders. Clients are responsible for completing arrangements prior to the date of the assessment. If a sample cannot be provided on the scheduled date, a rescheduling fee may apply at Availia's discretion. Rescheduling is not guaranteed.

If Your Assessment is Virtual:

Participate from a private, distraction-free space and remain present and engaged for the full duration of the session. Promptly communicate any delays or technical difficulties. You are responsible for arranging your own urinalysis provider for the same date. All required documents must be signed and returned digitally prior to or on the day of your appointment.

A Note on Self-Reporting:

Honest self-reporting is required. Assessment findings are shared with your referring professional as authorized by your signed Release of Information and may be compared against information in their records. Inaccurate or incomplete reporting may affect the validity of your results.

Payment:

Payment is due at time of service. See the enclosed fee schedule or contact us in advance with questions about payment or financial accessibility.

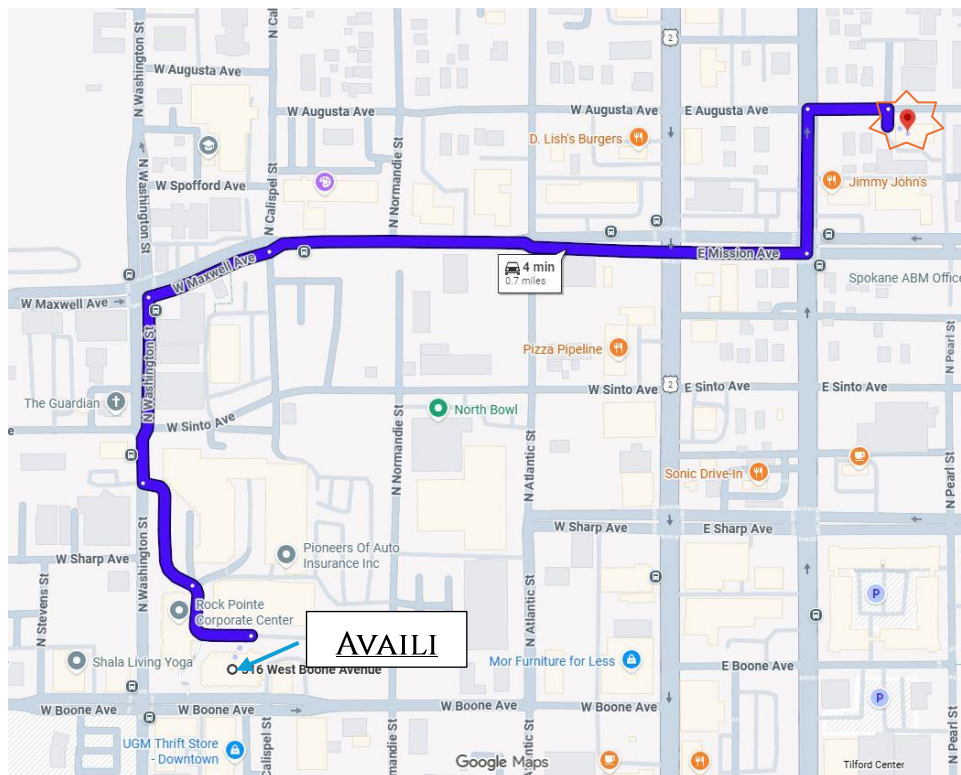

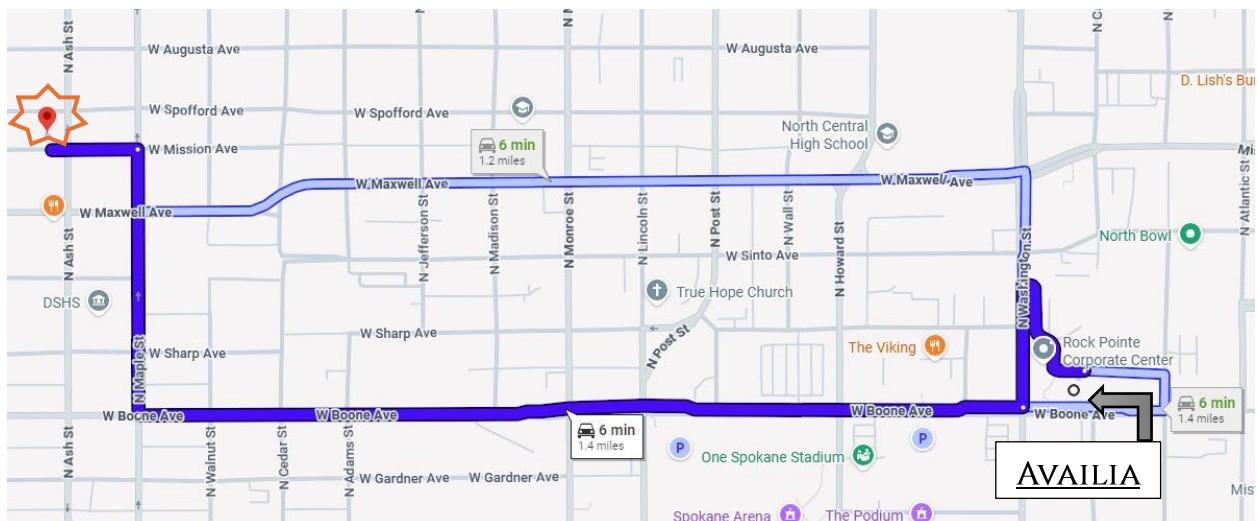
